Using IMCORE as a resource a regional partnership has been developed. Government Office North East, Environment Agency, Natural England, North East Climate Change Partnership and the Northumberland Coast AONB are in this partnership which has led to **ForeSea**.

The North East IMCORE partners (Envision and Durham County Council) are developing Foresea within the region aiming to produce **three** regional level outcomes.

Together these three outcomes will assist the North East to adapt to the impacts of climate change in coastal areas.
